She will also cover the importance of the camera sensor, histograms, photo composition, and "the golden hour" (the best time to shoot outdoors). She will present some basic photo processing tools, editing basics, and ways to take a good picture to make it a "WOW" picture. Time permitting, she will also present some "fun" stuff to do with images for photos that shine!
